

NJCA Grand Prix 2011/12

1. Nature of the Event

The Grand Prix is a year-long individual competition based on all of NJCA events. The Grand Prix begins on 1st September 2011 and ends on 30th June 2012.

2. Grand Prix Sections

The NJCA Grand Prix is divided into two sections: -

- (1) Open Prix: open to all Members of all ages
- (2) Female Prix: Open to all girls of all ages

3. Grand Prix Scoring

Grand Prix points may be scored in any number of events.

(a) Scoring Grand Prix points in an event

- The Member must play at least four games in the event.
- Players will receive 3 points for a win and 1 point for a draw

(b) Calculating overall Grand Prix scores

Grand Prix scores will be calculated on the Member's best performances in up to 3 events.

In the case of a tie, the next highest event result will act as a tiebreak. If necessary, a tie-breaker will be held.

The leading scores will be published from time to time, and the final scores will be published in early July.

4. Prizes

The winner of each Prix will receive a wooden chess set and board. Additionally there will be vouchers for 2nd place in both prix and a commemorative book plate from the NJCA.

A Member may win prizes in more than one section.

5. Application of Rules

The application of these rules, and any decisions relating to them, rests solely with the NJCA.
