

The Warwick Terafinal Competition August 2010

Only Zheming Zhang from the NJCA got through to the UK Chess Challenge Terafinal this year. He scored 10 points out of a possible 18 (3 wins, 1 draw and 2 losses) in a competition which included children up to the age of 18. This was the highest score for an Under-9 and Zheming won a prize of £300

Amarvansh Singh Wadhwa played in the Challengers Tournament, a sort of second division. He scored 13 points (4 wins, a draw and a loss). This allowed him to share 5th place and won him a prize of £40.
